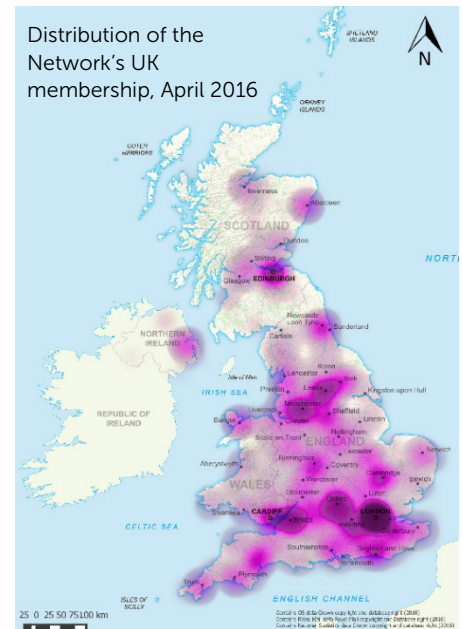


Opportunities for Corporate and Lead Partners, 2016 to 2017
